US YOUTH SOCCER NATIONAL YOUTH LICENSE

The National Youth License, a U.S. Soccer course, focuses upon the nature of children and the adjustments adults must make to coach them. The course curriculum covers the ages of 4-12 years old. Each day of the course, the focus is upon one of the traditional soccer age groups of U6, U8, U10 or U12. Each day, children of the appropriate age group are brought to the course site for the candidates to work with them in a practice training session. The candidates are videotaped while coaching the kids and the video is reviewed with each candidate to aid in the education of the coach. The course combines both classroom (theory) and field (practical) sessions. The course concludes with written, oral and practical examinations. The National Youth License course is six days in length, sometimes being held over two weekends or six consecutive days. It is ideal for anyone hoping to become a better and more effective coach to take this course. We hope to see you in June!

What is the National Youth License?

The National Youth License is designed to provide club directors of coaching, youth coaches, and soccer administrators with the knowledge to successfully structure soccer environments for children aged 4-12. Youth coaches have a tremendous influence on the development of a child's life-long passion for the game, and the National Youth License was created with that in mind.

Each day is broken down by traditional soccer age groups; U-6, U-8, U-10 and U-12. Teams of appropriate aged children are used each day in the training of the candidates. Video technology is used during the course as a method of training and evaluation. Those who wish to serve as state and local Youth Module Instructors are identified and certified within this course.

What is required to earn a National Youth License?

In order to earn the National Youth License, candidates must:

- Attend all field and classroom sessions
- Submit Care and Prevention / Risk Management tests (group work)
- Make presentations on Team/Risk Management
- Complete a Practice Coaching Session (1 practice opportunity per candidate).
Candidates are videotaped during this session. The sessions are then reviewed each evening by the staff coach and by fellow candidates.
- Complete a Candidates Journal (take home)
- Complete a Practical Coaching session (formal evaluated by the coaching staff)

What should I expect from the course in terms of classroom or field participation?

Each day features classroom lecture/discussion sessions and field sessions. Candidates are strongly urged to physically prepare for the course. There are no physical tests, but participation is enjoyable and a valuable way to learn through experience.

Are there any prerequisites required for the National Youth License?

Candidates must be 18 years old and hold a minimum of an E Certificate or have approval from their respective State Director of Coaching to attend.

Do "A" License Coaches receive 8 CEU's for taking the course and passing?

Yes, this is new and approved by USSF, a great way to further your education and receive a full allotment of CEU's.

How much does the National Youth License Cost?

The course tuition is \$375.00.

Is lodging included in the registration fee?

What is included in the course fee?

The course fee includes course administration, staff costs, material fees, USSF Coaching Education T-shirt, and a 1-year membership to the US Soccer Coaches Organization.

How many people can register for the course?

The maximum enrollment is 36 candidates.

How can I register for the National Youth License?

Application: A \$200.00 non-refundable application fee or full tuition is due by May 1, 2008.

A copy of the candidate's license must accompany the application. The course balance must be paid in full no later than two weeks prior to the start of the course (June 1, 2008). Applicants failing to submit final payment by the deadline are subject to having their registration cancelled.
